







- 65% of Development Permits issued were Non-Residential

Overview

- In 2016 institutional values were high because of Mary Bergeron (\$9,000,000).
- In 2020 Tesla Electric Vehicle Charge Station, Chrysler Development and the Clubhouse at the Golf Course were major permits to be issued.
- In 2021 Waschuk Pipeline Construction were major industrial permits to be issued (x3 permits totaling \$6,000,000).
