Position Duties:

- Provide regular preventative maintenance on all vehicles and equipment.
- Provide repair work on all vehicles and equipment.
- Conduct basic welding and cutting duties.
- Shall provide assistance with respect to advice on major repairs, replacements, new purchases, etc.
- Maintain a thorough and complete record of all preventative maintenance and repair work conducted on all vehicles and equipment.
- Assist in the receipt of goods delivered to the Public Works Yard and garage.
- Attend position related seminars/courses as directed by the Supervisor.
- Actively participate in Formal Workplace Inspections in area of responsibility
- Review pertinent Hazard Identification, Assessment and Control worksheets on an annual basis as required by the Municipal Health and Safety Program
- Follow all Safe Work Practices and Procedures
- Immediately report any unsafe conditions, potential work hazards or incidents to Supervisor
