## Intersection Changes

**Edson, Alberta, June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020** – Motorists will notice some signage changes in the coming weeks.

In early July, two locations on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue will see changes. The most noticeable change will be on 6<sup>th</sup> Ave and 50<sup>th</sup> Street, which will become a 4-way stop. This intersection has been identified as a problem area with low visibility and high traffic. A 4-way stop will also reduce speeds as motorists enter the downtown area.

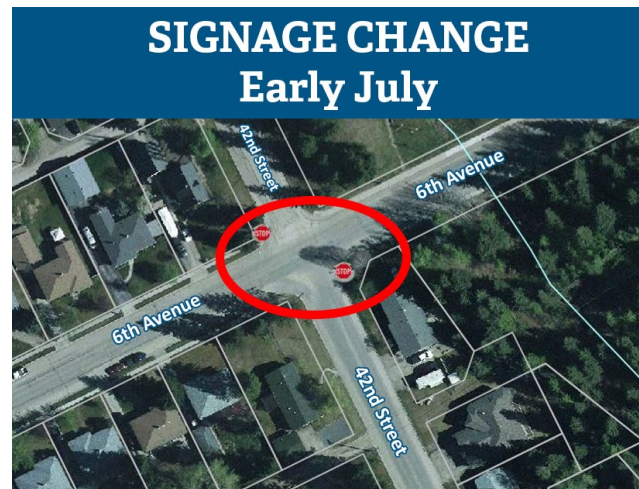
The second location is at 42<sup>nd</sup> Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The yield signs on the north and south sides of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be replaced with stop signs. Again, this location has been identified as a high-risk area and it's hoped stop signs will help reduce the potential for collisions.

Sign installation is planned for the second week of July.
