

Grief is a normal emotion to emerge after the loss of a loved one, pet, job or something else.


It affects everyone differently and requires time and compassion in order to process it.


Eligibility Requirements:

Income Thresholds are as follows:

1 person income \$35,000 or less 2 person income \$45,000 or less 3 person income is \$47,500 or less 4 person income is \$50,000 or less 5 person income is \$52,500 or less and increases by \$2,500 per individual per family thereafter






