# Winter Swimming Lessons

## Important information:

\*NEW\*: We are piloting 1 day a week group swimming lesson. We welcome respectful feedback via email. [katieb@edson.ca](mailto:katieb@edson.ca)

For the safety of swimmers and instructors Preschool 1 requires a caregiver in the water. Once Preschool 1 has been passed a caregiver is not required for Preschool 2+. If your swimmer is shy, we welcome caregivers in the water for all levels.

It is not required to call in absent for a swimming lesson. Swimming lessons are evaluated daily, missing lessons does not mean failure. Please do not bring swimmers that are injured, ill or that have open wounds.

Swimmers are required to have passed the previous level. Swimmers that are registered in levels that are too advanced will be moved to correct level if there is space. If there is not space in the correct level a refund will be applied to the swimmers' active net account minus the \$10 administration fee. If you are unaware what level to place your swimmer in, contact [katieb@edson.ca](mailto:katieb@edson.ca) to book an evaluation. (\$10 fee)

## Cancellation & Refund Policy:

Course/programs may be cancelled at the Town's discretion, if that happens you will be notified, and a complete refund will be issued. If registrants withdraw from a program more than 1 week prior to the start of a program a full refund will be issued to the registrants Active Net account or via Electronic Funds Transfer. If the registrants withdraw from a program less than 1 week prior to the start of the program a \$10 administration fee will be charged, and the remaining amount will be placed on the registrants Active Net account or via Electronic Funds Transfer. No refunds will be issued after the start of a program. We cannot refund online transaction fees.

# Welcome to Swimming Lessons!



The Town of Edson is an affiliate of the Lifesaving Society of Alberta. All our instructors have completed the 32-hour Swim Instructor course, 40-hour National Lifeguard course as well as the 16-hour Standard First Aid course. Our priority is the safety of our guests. Please take a minute to read the below expectations while visiting for swimming lessons.

## Swimming Lesson Information:

- *No pictures/videos of other swimmers or instructors are permitted.*
- If a swimmer is under 8 years of age a caregiver (aged 13+) must be in the pool area for the entire lesson.
- Outdoor footwear is not permitted in changing rooms or viewing area. Please place shoes on boot rack.
- Caregivers of Preschoolers should be prepared to accompany shy/nervous swimmers into lessons until they are comfortable.
- Please report any relevant medical conditions to Instructor. Ex. Asthma, Diabetes, Epilepsy etc.
- In the event of an emergency follow Instructors directions.
- Swimmers are not permitted if they are ill. Ex. Cold, Flu, open wounds etc.
- Swimmers wait in the viewing area until the instructor calls their class.
- Children that are not in lessons stay in the viewing area. Please do not allow children to climb on bleachers or run on the pool deck.
- There is no food or glass allowed in the viewing area. Drink containers that will not break *ARE* allowed.
- Swimmers with long hair should have it tied back out of their face for the best success.
- 1-piece swimsuits are recommended for swimmer comfort.
- Goggles should be in working order. Tempered glass goggles are not permitted.
- Treat Instructors, fellow swimmers, and facility with respect.
- Swimmers that are not following instructions will be asked to sit on the edge of the pool.
- Swimmers that continue to be a safety concern will be sent to their caregivers.
- *Report cards will be ready for pick up the day after the last lesson has occurred.*
- If a guardian has any concerns, please speak to the instructor after the lesson.
