COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX PROGRAM

Town of Edson Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) is looking for volunteers 18 years of age or older who are interested in helping out with the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program in 2020.

This program runs annually and there are many roles volunteers can play. From checking files before they're completed to filling out intake forms with members of the public. There are tasks that can be done at home and during clinic hours.
